We understand that emergencies occur on occasion, and therefore, we ask that you simply send in a note, phone call, email or fax the teacher and Principal to let us know.

**All violations of the dress code policy will be reviewed by the Principal and the sole decision rests with the principal.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Layering tops is permissible provided both garments are solid AND are of uniform colors. They need not be the same color. **Purses** are not permitted during the school day.

Ties are encouraged but not required.

Uniforms: Girl/Boy Scout, Athletic Uniform Tops (Grades 7-8 only) may be worn on meeting or game days.

DRESS DOWN DAYS: There may be dates scheduled for non-uniform days. Information will be sent home or posted on our social media pages. Clothing should be free from inappropriate slogans and sayings and an acceptable length.

GYM DAY: Plain/ solid color navy blue sweatpants, sweat/gym shorts may be worn. Sweatpants and sweatshirts must be solid color, or with white stripes only. No other decorations are allowed with the exception of the GPA name and or a small logo. Students may also wear a plain white or navy t-shirt. Gym shoes must be worn on Gym days.
