START OF STATE TESTING WEEK!

Parents,

I just looked at our preliminary I-Ready Diagnostic Data and I am extremely impressed! We are rocking it! Most classes are showing over 90% growth. I just wanted to say thank you, thank you, thank you! We still have a few more students that need to complete the testing but it is looking extremely promising.

For students in grades 3-8 they will begin taking the State Test in Reading next week and Math the first of April. It is important that we keep our eye on the prize and don't give up. The Diagnostic was our final step in preparing for the State Test.

If they can perform at the same or similar pace then our results will exceed our goal for the year! It is my/our belief that every student can pass!

Keep pushing we are almost there!

Also, please continue to monitor your child's social media pages and cell phone messages. Over the last several weeks we have noticed an increased amount of inappropriate text messages/pictures/conversations etc. on Snap Chat, Instagram, Text etc. that have a direct effect on the social climate in the building. Please note that if the problem interferes with the instructional day, your child can/will be disciplined here at school. Additionally, it is important to note that cell phones are expected to be placed in book bags during the school day. Any phones found on a student will be confiscated and the parent must pick up.

COVID Updates

We are starting to see a reduction in the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in our community. In response to that trend, the Ohio Department of Health and the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department (TLCDH) have revised their guidelines for responding to positive cases of COVID-19.

Based on the updated COVID-19 guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Toledo Lucas-County Health Department, masks and face coverings will be optional for Toledo Public School students and staff members beginning, Wednesday, March 2, 2022, that includes when riding a TPS bus. District officials will continue to monitor the number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our community. Revision to the district's safety protocols could be made if there is a significant increase in confirmed cases or new regulations are issued from health officials.

Principals are now required to notify families twice a week with the number of current confirmed cases of COVID-19 in their school. This notification will be made by using the district's mass notification system. The district will continue to post a weekly report that shows district-wide numbers of confirmed cases.

- · Students and staff members who are directly exposed to COVID-19, regardless of the setting (home, community, school), will continue to be able to attend school as long as they remain symptom free.
- · Under the direction of TLCHD, TPS will assist with contact tracing for any outbreaks or clusters of COVID 19 at school. And as a reminder, TPS and TLCHD encourage everyone to stay up-to-date with their vaccines including boosters, to wear a mask, practice social distancing and to stay home if you are sick and get tested. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact the school.

As of 3/9/22 We have (0) Confirmed Covid Positive Students or Staff at Grove Patterson Academy.

Our school-based health centers offer COVID-19 testing (PCR and Rapid/antigen) and vaccines. COVID Protocols

It is extremely important that you assess your child every morning before arriving to school. If your child has any of the following symptoms, they should remain at home. You should contact Nurse G. for further guidance:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle, body aches, head aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Close contact (within 6 feet for 15+ minutes) with someone who has a confirmed case of Covid-19 or someone who has exhibited symptoms of COVID-19.

If your child has any of these symptoms upon arriving to school they will be sent home.

Testing Updates

Our students will continue taking the final I-Ready Diagnostic Test. All students in grades 1-6 took the Reading Diagnostic on Thursday, March 3, 2022. K,7/8 will take their tests 3/3-3/17. Grades 1-6 will also take the math during this time as well. Your child's teacher will send to you their specific schedule.

Keep in mind this final diagnostic will prepare students as they take the Ohio State Assessment beginning on 3/14.

Here is a video to watch to explain the diagnostic and to maybe answer some questions you might have. Our students have demonstrated tremendous growth during each exam and I am looking forward to the upcoming results. I am so proud of them and our staff!!! ~Mrs. J.

It is important that students are taking their time on this Diagnostic so teachers can close any educational gaps that exist as well as help enrichment academic performance. As we wrap up our Diagnostics students will be responsible for 30 minutes of Reading and 30 minutes of Math each week. This is a minimum goal. Students CAN work at home and should have their username and password. The maximum time spent should be 45 minutes per week.

How can you help?

- Have your students log-in and go to the My Progress Tab.
- Look at the following
 - o Time on Task
 - o Lessons Passed
 - Lesson Streak
 - Completed Work
- Acknowledge your child for receiving a 75% or higher.
- Reinforce that students are to take this seriously and remind them that we all want to see them be successful!

It is important to remember that this test is a Third Grade Reading Guarantee qualifier and any 3rd grade student that receives a 505 or higher will be considered to have passed. No students will be retained in grade 3 based upon their OST scores due to the passing of new legislation for this year only. However, it is important to stress that we want all of our students to pass both the I-Ready Diagnostic and the State Achievement Assessment.

It is important that all families speak with their child about the important of this test.

Teachers should have notified you on when students will be taking this Diagnostic. If you do not have this information, I encourage you to speak with your child's teacher.

DROP OFF SUPPLIES/LUNCH

We are attempting to limit the amount of disruptions we have to the learning day. You would be surprised how many times we must contact a teacher's classroom. If these items are brought, we will ask that you take them home.

Additionally, we have had many parents over the last several weeks ordering or bringing in/dropping off outside lunches or even some ordering from Grub Hub etc. Please note our policy is, your child can bring outside food items from home in their lunch boxes/bag, however they cannot be dropped off during the school day and will be turned away.

If any changes must be made to how a child is getting home, it must be done before 2:00 p.m. Many parents are texting, emailing, or calling during the middle of dismissal. It is no way we can notify teachers/children after 2:00 pm. It is simply too chaotic. Parents should also not text/call their child to get off the bus. It is no way we can confirm it was the parent. Note, once a student is on the bus, we will not get a student off the bus unless it is an emergency. This is a safety concern and will be adhered to.

Please remember that students who are dropped off in the morning by car must remain in their vehicles until 7:55 a.m. Over the last several weeks I have noticed more and more students coming into the building earlier than they are supposed to. We must maintain a certain level of distancing that requires only bus riders (and a limited other exceptions) to enter the building before 7:55 a.m. Students will be asked to return to the vehicle if it is before the time. I apologize in advance.

Walking School Bus Survey

Please take a moment to fill out the interest survey. Students interested in getting fit by walking or cycling can join our Walking School Bus Club. It's a club focused on getting more exercise in the great outdoors. Our club will walk from school every Wednesday to a designated location where parents can pick the kids up. Students will depart from Grove immediately after the busses have left and walk almost ½ mile to our pick up location. Kids get exercise and parents get a potentially faster pick up. Students will be able to earn incentives for the amount of times (miles/steps) they participate in. We just need to know how many are interested in participating so that we can determine how many adults we will need to volunteer.

Bussing Information

We are excited to announce that you have access to a new smartphone app that helps to improve communication, school bus safety, and efficiency. The Transportation Portal (aka Edulog Parent Portal) app provides you with planned time and location information for your child's bus ride to school. On a daily basis, the app will how you the GPA location of the bus and send you a push notification when it is nearing your bus stop.

The app is free of charge for our parents, caregivers, and students. In addition to displaying the location of your bus and sending the notifications, you can also receive time sensitive messages from our transportation department. You will also receive notification when a substitute bus is running your route due to scheduled maintenance on your regular bus, for example.

The app can be downloaded from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store-either of which can be accessed by pointing your smartphone camera at this QR code:
